Minutes:

- Jim read the minutes from the February Board Meeting. A motion was made and passed to accept them as recorded.

Financials:

- Judy reported a checking account balance of \$17,309.27 as of 3/30/2012.
- Two deposits totaling \$455
- We added 13 members. Total membership is 241.
- Lights = \$552.07 for 30 lights. (LG&E is not billing for 6 streetlights. We should be paying for a total of 36 streetlights.)
- A motion was made and passed to accept the finances as reported.

Old Business

A. Reminder Dues Letter

- Judy has draft with changes made. She gave it to the group to review.
- We'll need to purchase more envelopes. Les instructed Judy to purchase whatever supplies she needs.
- Once Judy gets all the supplies together, we'll schedule an envelope stuffing session (sometime after Derby)

B. Mary Herne (sp?) dead tree in the easement behind her yard (previously reported)

- Metro Call was registered by Judy. Metro Call did inspect it, but no work order issue. Apparently the neighbor will have to take it out themselves.

New Business:

A. Brightside Naturescape Garden & Beautification Grants

- Judy got a grant form in the last Brightside Community Cleanup package (if anyone is interested in doing beautification).

B. Note from Jim Alvey (sp?) (he sent it with his dues)

- Concerned about the population of mosquitoes from Beargrass Creek.
- Also concerned about the grass in the common area of Raintree.
- Judy responded and recommended that for the mosquitoes, to put in a call to MetroCall. He said he did that last year and nothing was done. She also told him what Kevin Kremer was trying to do with the Raintree property.

C. New Streetlights?

- Les suggested that we reform a streetlight committee and decide upon possible locations for new lights. Les has the large plastic map. Judy mapped out all locations and addresses of each light.
- Les to call a meeting.
- Les to email Kevin Kremer's office (Erin Henson) to inquire if there is still grant money for solar lights.
