

**Four Seasons Neighborhood Association (FSNA)**  
Board Meeting  
**October 3, 2011, 7:00 PM – Hunsinger Lane Baptist Church**

**Minutes:**

- Jim read the minutes from the August Board Meeting. A motion was made and passed to accept them as recorded.

**Financials:**

- Judy reported a checking account balance of \$13,358.40 as of 9/30/2011.
- Paid street light bill in September for \$547.45. No ad income for last month.
- \$1,637.97 needed to finish street light bills for the rest of 2011.
- Rcvd \$70 in dues for 2 new members. That puts us at 216 total members
- A motion was made and passed to accept the financials as reported.

**Elections:**

- Officer/Board elections will be conducted at the November general meeting. That meeting was previously announced in the newsletter to be Thursday November 17, but we have since found that the church cannot let us use a room on that date. We therefore have to move the general meeting to Thursday November 10.
- At the last general meeting in September, David Lynch volunteered to coordinate board nominations again.
- Judy re-up for the Treasurer nomination. She has served for half-term taking for over Sandy.

**Elections Flyer/Newsletter:**

- The group decided that instead of a regular newsletter prior to the November general meeting, we need to have a one page “flyer” focused on one thing only – the elections. No ads. No articles.
- We need to emphasize the change in the meeting date to November 10, and let neighbors know that the meeting focus will be nominating and electing officers and board members for 2012 – and that they can nominate themselves.
- We decided we would like to have this printed and ready for distribution over the Halloween weekend, giving everyone over a week’s notice of the meeting and its changed date.

**Brightside:**

- We will once again pick up trash along the Raintree common area on Brightside Community Clean-up Day October 22, starting at 9:00 AM.
- Jim will pick up the supplies Oct. 15.

**No dumping sign for Raintree:**

- Judy had inquired about having metro put in “No Dumping” signs along Raintree. They no longer install those signs as they have found them to be counterproductive.
- Perhaps we can get a Scout troop or another group to adopt that stretch and keep it picked up. This can be coordinated/recorded through Brightside.

**Supplies:**

- We ran out of paper, so UPS printed the last newsletter on paper they supplied which doubled the cost of printing. Judy took them 2,500 sheets to prevent that from happening again.

**Streetlight banners:**

- David, Les and Jim will take the two streetlight banners down this Wednesday.

**Solar streetlight:**

- Unknown status. Need to call Kevin Kramer’s office.

**New Neighbor Welcome letter:**

- Becky suggested giving a welcome letter to new neighbors with an explanation of the neighborhood association and what it does.

**Meeting frequency:**

- We discussed the possibility of changing the frequency of the General and Board meetings. Perhaps quarterly instead of bi-monthly, and maybe hold the board meeting the same night as general meeting.
