A golden alert was sent out for her for months with no success. Later they discovered her body in a closet. The house is owned by someone in Florida, she has been contacted and said there will be a new front door installed soon, no commitment on the grass and shrubs.

The last house on Summerfield on the left before heading into Four Seasons II is in foreclosure. The volunteers who cut the area between Four Seasons and Four Seasons II have been cutting grass. The mortgage company has no interest in putting money into the property. THANK YOU VOLUNTEERS.

Street lights - Les reported that he had spoken with the homeowner in the middle of the block on Petty Jay about putting the street light in front of his house. They would have to allow a five feet wide easement to be recorded on the deed. It was also discussed that we might need to install two lights instead of one. Les will contact LG&E for more guidance.
