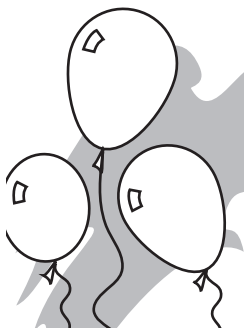


### Corner
